April 17 - A Vision Leading Us into the FUTURE

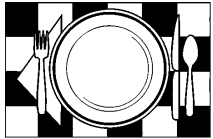

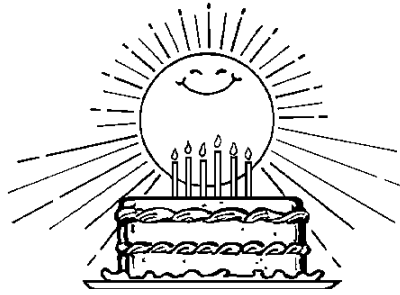
