Dear Friends,

Our Imagine 2020 Leadership Team has been meeting now for more than a month. As you know this team is guiding our congregation through a strategic planning process. Please make plans to participate in the three congregational conversations so that you may offer your input about our future mission as a church. The first conversation was held in Sunday, February 27 and focused on "a vision grounded in our PAST." The next two conversations will be:

Sunday, March 20 at 4:30 pm - A Vision Tied to our PRESENT
Sunday, April 17 at 4:30 pm - A Vision Leading Us into the FUTURE

In addition to these congregational gatherings we will be hosting two "community forums" where we are inviting civic, social service and educational leaders in our community to give us their perspectives on the anticipated needs of Cartersville and Bartow County over the next decade. We will be asking these community leaders to share with us how they think our church can make a difference in the place where God has planted us. I hope you will come out to these forums. They will be held on

Wednesday, March 30 at 6:30 pm - Civic leaders forum
Wednesday, April 13 at 6:30 pm - Social service/Educational leaders forum

One of the interesting things that the leadership team has already done is begin to look at the present and projected demographics within a 10 mile radius of our church. Our final report will give more detail, but here are just a few items of information we found interesting:

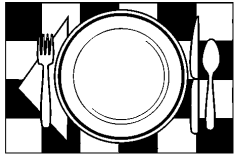
- The population in 2010 was 97,225 and *is expected to grow by 16.8% by 2015* to 113,552.
- The largest expected population increase will be in persons 18-24 years of age and persons 55 and older.
- The greatest increase over the next 5 years will be in households with annual incomes of \$100,000 - \$149,999.
- Overall educational levels in our community are lower than the state average.

This is just a taste of the data we have looked at. The full reports we are looking at are available in the church office for any who would like to read them. Of course, the task of the leadership team is to prayerfully review all the data and formulate it's meaning for our church's future. Keep the team in your prayers and remember to participate in the process that we may "follow God into the future."

Ash Wednesday Service – March 9 at 6:45 PM

The season of Lent begins March 9th. As we traditionally have, we will begin the 40-day period with a special worship time in the sanctuary at 6:45. One of the most blessed services of the year, Ash Wednesday provides us with the chance to review our spiritual commitments as we contemplate the journey of Christ to the cross. As in the past, the imposition of ashes and a ritual of self-examination will be offered.

At its stated monthly meeting of Feb. 8, 2011, the Session made the following decisions:

- Upon a recommendation from the Stewardship and Finance Committee, the Session voted unanimously to accept a 2011 balanced budget of \$816,206. Last year's budget was \$752,000. The increases are due mainly to pay raises given to all staff members and to an increase in the contract for janitorial services.
- Upon a recommendation from the Worship Committee, the Session voted unanimously to continue the current schedule for communion at Sunday and special worship services.
- Upon a recommendation from the Diaconate, the Session gave unanimous approval to a set of guidelines for funerals to be held at FPC.

Committee reports:

Stewardship and Finance: The committee reported that the church ended the 2010 budget year in the black with a surplus of about \$11,500. The church ended the month of January with a surplus of \$114 for the year, a pleasant surprise that may be due to the paying of church pledges for 2011 at the beginning of the month by several members.

Worship: The committee submitted a plan for summer worship for the Session's consideration. The plan calls for one worship service at 11 a.m. in the sanctuary on Sundays in June, followed by Just as I Am July, when one worship service is held at 11 a.m. in the Fellowship Hall. The idea is to provide more opportunities for the entire congregation to worship together, and in June, when attendance is lower, space is not as scarce. Concerns are that going eight weeks without the other two services could be too disruptive. The Session will pray about and consider the proposal further.

Christian Education: More than 50 people have gone through the Safe Sanctuaries training sessions to prepare them for working with children and youth. The committee has a Vacation Bible School subcommittee that has chosen to write its own curriculum for VBS this year. Two fundraisers benefitting youth trip scholarships are scheduled – a pancake brunch on March 6 and a spaghetti dinner on May 18.

Diaconate: The Mission and Witness Committee's last blood drive had 60 donors. The next drive is set for March 2. On that day, please welcome visitors to our church. At the Souper Bowl of Caring luncheon, our church and Heritage Baptist Church raised \$1,376.13 for Backpack Buddies.

After School Program: The ASP board and the Christian Education Committee are working out how the Safe Sanctuaries policy may apply to the program, which has several high school and college students who are not church members as volunteers.

Special Discussion: Elder Bobby Bergman presented information about the new form of government that is being voted on at the March 22 meeting of Cherokee Presbytery. As one of FPC's commissioners to the meeting, Bergman has attended an information session about the differences between the current form of government and the wholesale revision of the Book of Order that is being voted on by presbyteries across the Presbyterian Church. He discussed the changes and received feedback about them from the Session.

Milestones:

New Members: Betty Gilbert was welcomed into church membership on Jan. 16 by transfer of letter from Sam Jones UMC. Harold and Lois Brown were welcomed into membership on Jan. 16 by transfer of letter from Waleska United Methodist Church.

Baptisms: Samantha Caroline Porter, daughter of Clayton and Melissa Porter, was baptized at the 9:45 a.m. service on Feb. 13. Mary Elizabeth Hackney, daughter of Wes and Macie Hackney, was baptized at the 11 a.m. service on Feb. 13.

Report of the Annual Congregational Meeting

The congregation had its annual celebration dinner on Sunday, February 13. In addition to delicious food, delightful fellowship and fantastic music by Rob Sims and Jerry Brownlow, the congregation also conducted some business.

- The 2010 Annual Report was received. If you were not present at the meeting, copies are available around church.
- The 2011 Church Budget, approved by the Session, was presented. Thanks to a generous response from the congregation, the Session was able to present a balanced budget of \$816,000. It was also noted that the church finished 2010 with a surplus of \$11,537. Copies of the 2011 budget are available in the church office.
- The Personnel Committee presented a report that 6% increases were given to all staff members for 2011 – the first raises for church staff in 3 years.
- The congregation approved salary increases of 6% for the Pastor and the Associate Pastor.
- The Officer Nominating Committee was elected. Those elected were Bobby Bergman (chairman), Jo Clark, Trey Gaines, Emily Gilreath, Weston Melton, Lisa Greeby, Tom Nebergall, and Stan Tilley.

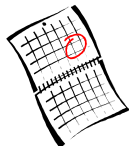

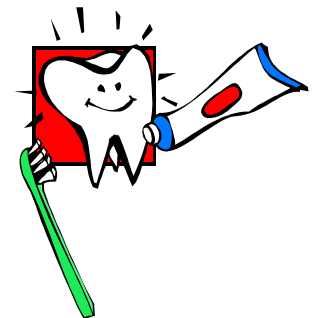

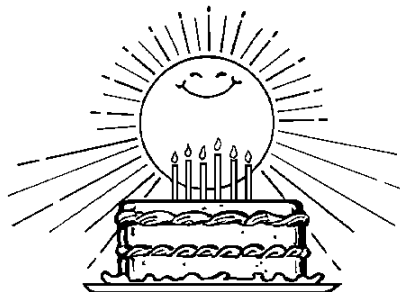
