Dear Friends,

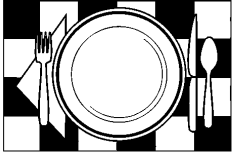

Committee Reports:

Stewardship and Finance: The church has a deficit of about \$138,000 for the year, which is better than it was at the same time last year by about \$5,000 to \$6,000. Expenses are at about 75 percent of budget through September, which is right on target. Income is lagging. The committee is hopeful that income will trend up over the last three months, as it did last year, and asks for the prayers of the Session about this continuing difficult situation. Planning continues for Consecration Sunday, which is in November.

Christian Education: On Sept. 20, twenty youth and seven adults helped with Health Day for the Homeless in downtown in Atlanta. Our church donated more than 100 pairs of blue jeans. A slide show about the effort will be shown on Youth Sunday Service Day in November.

Properties: Money has been raised to replace the sanctuary doors, and that project will begin soon. Norman Daugherty is overseeing it. Work on moving and adding mulch to the playground is going to be done as part of an Eagle Scout project by Weston Melton. A recent fire inspection revealed a few small issues that will be handled.

Personnel: The search committee to find a new organist to replace the retiring Terry Strange includes Mary Gilreath, Allen Weirick, Susan Barrett, Rick Gomez and Ted Smith.

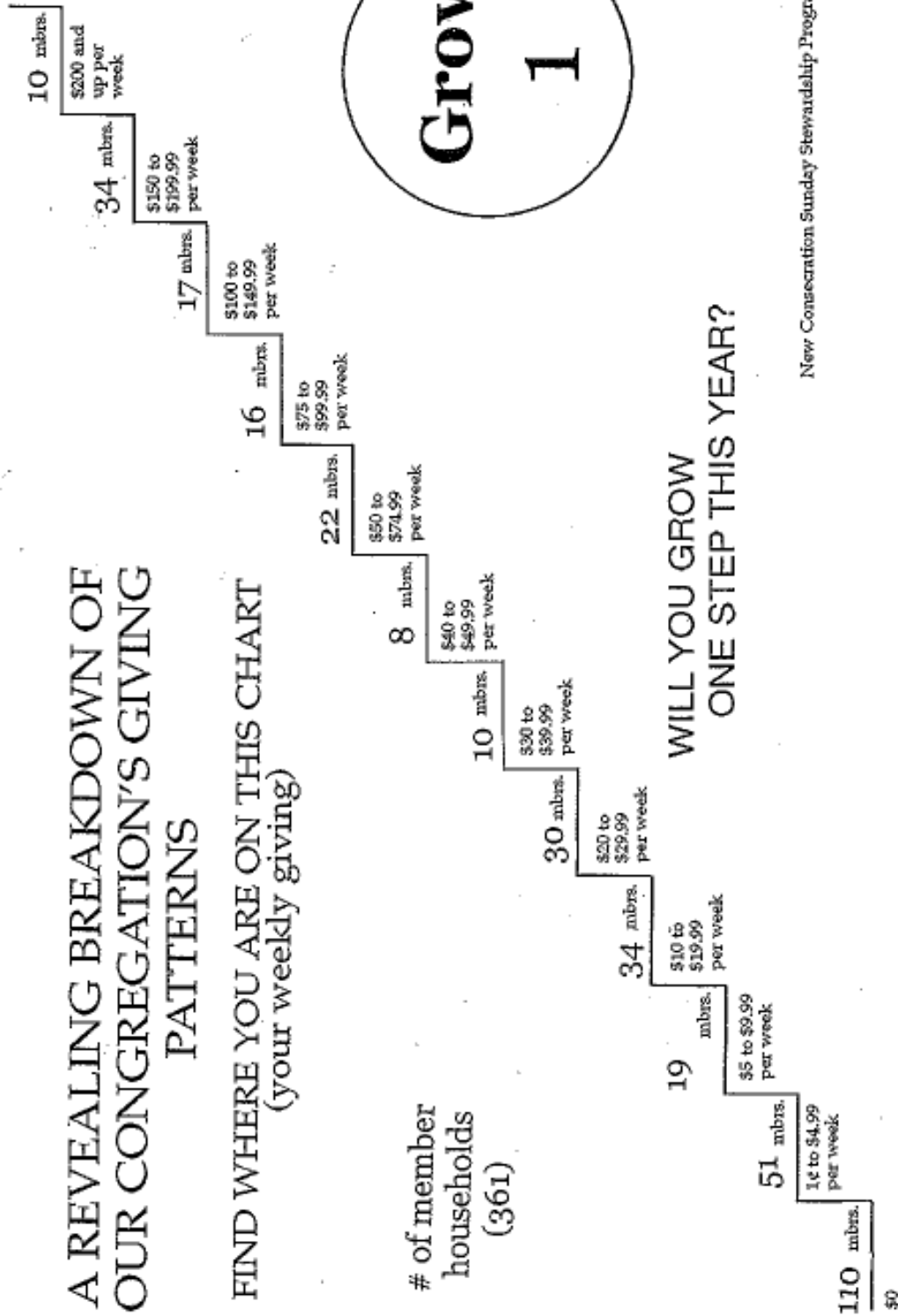
